Dear Freedom Rally Sponsor,

We would like to take this time to thank you for your donation towards our 16th. Annual Freedom Rally held on the August long weekend. We had 144 people attending with the furthest being from North Carolina. We are also celebrating the Freedom Riders 20th anniversary this year.

This year our donation of \$3,000.00 will once again go to the Pediatric Burn-Scar Garment Fund for what is known as "Second Skin" since this is "vitally needed" and "very expensive" but not covered through OHIP. We have donated \$9,260.00 to the Children's Burn Scar Garment Fund in the past five years.

In the past we have donated \$6,000.00 worth of teddy bears to the Air Ambulance's "Bear in the Air Program", over \$7,000.00 to the Telemedia Trust Fund, \$2,000.00 to the Children's Wish foundation, \$500.00 to the MCTV Lion's Club Telethon, \$500.00 to the War Amps Champs Program, \$500.00 plus 1,022 man hours to the Special Olympics, 8 Air conditioners to the Sudbury Regional Hospital Pediatric Ward and an electric wheelchair to the Lion's club. We have also helped other people's functions such as the employees of Q92, 790 and 105.3 fm, also known as WKRP, with a Pepsi drive which raised approximately \$6,000.00 for audio-visual equipment for 2 pediatric cancer care rooms, volunteered countless hours at the Muscular Dystrophy Summerfest, worked hundreds of hours for the 1998 Special Olympics Summer Games, helped repair used bicycles for Bikes For Kids & worked on many more volunteer events.

The Freedom Riders Motorcycle Association is able to help these worthy causes in part due to the support of the general public but mainly because of the generous contribution of charity minded businesses such as yours.
